The USC Norman Topping Student Aid Fund (NTSAF) is the only student-initiated, student-funded, primarily student-administered scholarship in the nation. The Topping Fund is administered by a 26-member Governing Board composed of a student Chair, 12 voting student members, one USG representative, one GSG representative, two Topping Scholars, three USC alumni, a faculty member, representatives from the Offices of Admission and Financial Aid, the Vice Provost of Undergraduate Programs (or designee), and the NTSAF Associate Director. The Governing Board oversees the long term policies of the NTSAF and is responsible for the annual selection of Topping Scholars.

A highly selective position, student representatives gain service to the University and local community, interact with applicants and Topping Scholars, participate in recruitment and outreach activities, and network with student leaders, faculty, and staff for a <u>two year</u> commitment.

Board members are required to attend the annual Fall Governing Board Retreat, (October, date TBD) and approximately two Governing Board meetings per month. Fall meetings will involve writing a new strategic planning document for the Fund. The spring and summer focus on scholarship application reading, interviewing, and scholar selection.
