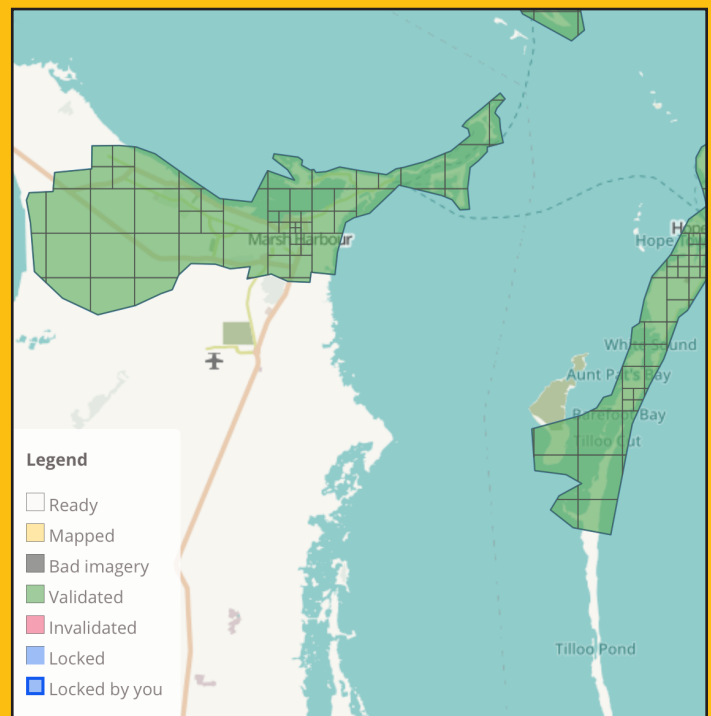


DO YOU CARE ABOUT CLIMATE CHANGE? DO YOU WANT TO MAKE A DIFFERENCE?
