
## How to add Vocareum in D2L


Once you have created your course in Vocareum and can log in, you will need to enable LTI. In your course settings, please enable LTI. **Don't forget to Save your settings!** 




If you already created programming assignments in Vocareum, you can now add it to D2L.

## 3. Add Links to Course


a. From Content area, select a module then select Existing Activities.




b. Select the new tab or iframe link.




c. The item is added to the module.
